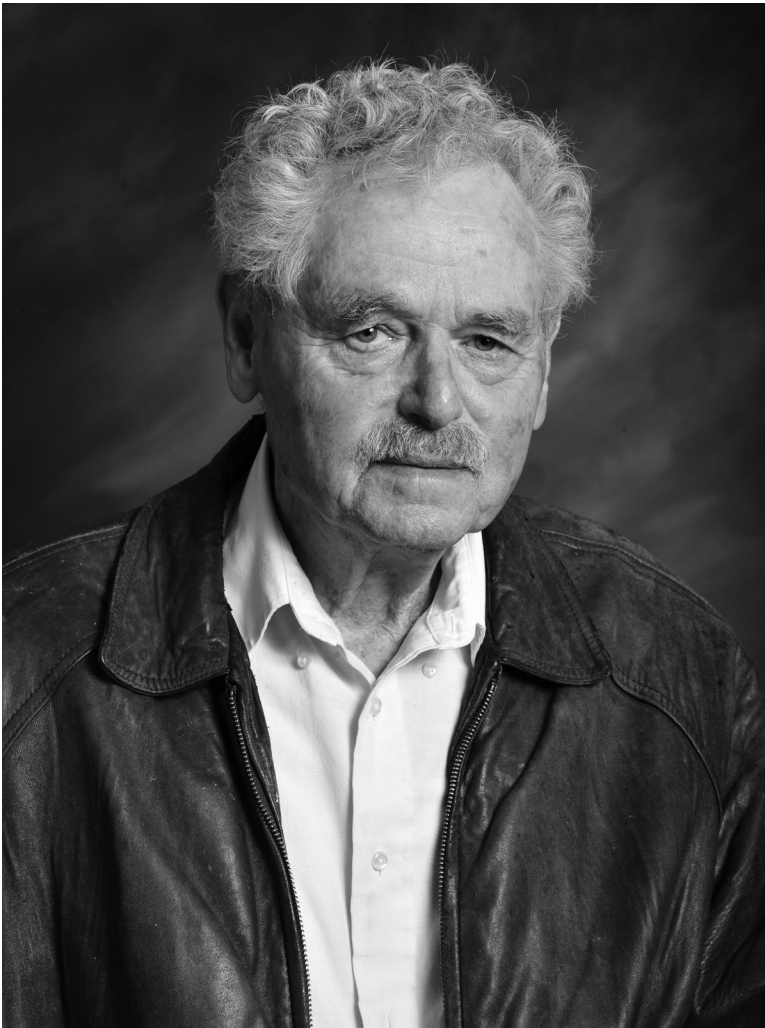


B i o g r a p h y
